BTech (SPECIAL & ACADEMIC) – IN-PERSON COUNSELLING INSTRUCTIONS

1. In person counselling

The candidate should appear **IN PERSON** for Counselling.

2. Call letters download

Eligible registered candidates can download their Counselling call letters from the website <https://adm.tanuvas.ac.in> to attend the counselling. Individual call letters will not be sent through post to the candidates. Candidates are informed to read the instructions given in call letter carefully.

3. Counselling

The candidate should report at the Counselling venue **one hour before** the stipulated time mentioned in the Counselling call letter on the specified date for the respective degree program. Eligible candidates can attend the counseling as per the date, time and rank mentioned in the schedule even if they are unable to download their call letter from the website.

4. Registering for counseling In-person

The candidate should register their attendance himself / herself for the Counselling within the stipulated time. They need to be present in the Counselling Hall and respond when their names are read out / called, failing which they will lose their chance of being selected.

5. **Admission**

Mere calling for counselling does not offer any guarantee for admission to UG degree programme. However, a waiting list of unselected candidates of offline counselling will be maintained for filling up the arising vacancy in future.

6. **Allotment**

The candidate who have been called for the Counselling will be selected on the basis of the aggregate (cut off) marks obtained by then (as mentioned in the Prospectus) and also on the basis of the vacancy position available at the constituent / affiliated colleges of the University following the community reservation rules of Tamil Nadu Government.

7. **Transfer and Conduct Certificates**

If the candidate has already joined in any other course, the candidate is advised **not to obtain Transfer and Conduct Certificates** from the Institution in which he / she is studying, as the Counselling in this University does not offer any guarantee for Selection. Hence, the evidence for having joined in other courses should be produced at the time of Counselling.

8. **Fees**

The selected candidate shall pay the prescribed fees for the first semester at the allotted college campus before the prescribed date and time. Failing which, he / she will not be considered thereafter.
