

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Sl. No.	Questions	Answers
A.	Eligibility	
1.	Whether NEET is mandatory for applying to BVSc & AH course in TANUVAS?	No. For BVSc & AH in Tamil Nadu state quota, NEET is not required. Candidates will be selected based on aggregate marks calculated from HSC marks. All India quota (15% of seats) will be filled through Veterinary Council of India based on NEET marks.
2.	I neither studied in Tamil Nadu nor a native of Tamil Nadu. Can I apply?	No. You can not apply under Tamil Nadu state quota. However, You can apply for All India quota (15 % seats) through the Veterinary Council of India.
3.	I have studied Maths, Physics, Chemistry and Computer science, but not biology. Can I apply for BVSc & AH?	No. The subject 'Biology' is essential for BVSc & AH degree programme in TANUVAS. For BVSc & AH, the eligible subjects in HSC are Physics, Chemistry and Biology (or) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.
4.	I have studied Maths, Physics, Chemistry and Computer science, but not biology (or) I have studied Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. Can I apply for BTech?	No. For BTech, the eligible subjects in HSC are Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
5.	I have studied in Government aided school (from 6 th to 12 th standard). Am I eligible to avail 7.5% reservation for Government school students?	No. Private and Government aided schools are not eligible to avail 7.5% reservation under Government school students category.

Sl. No.	Questions	Answers
6.	What will happen to my application, if my minimum eligible mark is lesser than required?	If you have scored the mark lesser than minimum requirement (under respective community / category) as eligible, your application will be rejected. Kindly refer the prospectus under section 4.1.4 Qualifying Examination and Minimum marks.
7.	I am one day or few days lesser than the lower age limit, am I eligible to apply? (Or) I am one day or few days higher than the upper age limit, am I eligible to apply?	No. You are not eligible to apply. Age relaxation (Both Lower and Upper limit) is not permissible on any grounds. Kindly refer the prospectus under section 4.1.2 Age limit.
B.	Registration and Application	
8.	While doing registration, I have not received the OTP in email. How to proceed?	While doing registration of your email ID, please verify you have entered the email ID correctly. Kindly verify your email Inbox in all the Tabs (Primary, Promotions, Social, Updates, Forum and Spam) and check for OTP.
9.	What is my user name?	Your registered email ID / mobile number will be your user name. Please make a note of these particulars and secure well for future reference and use for filling up options at the time of online counselling.
10.	Can I apply for both the courses (BVSc & AH and BTech) in a single entry?	Yes. Candidates can apply for both B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.Tech. (Food, Dairy & Poultry Technology) courses simultaneously through single entry, by clicking appropriate options and filling relevant information and paying application fee for the each course.

11.	What is the difference between constituent college and affiliated college?	<p>A constituent college is an integral unit of the University (TANUVAS) and the college is fully managed and controlled by the University.</p> <p>An affiliated college (AIIRLIVAS) is an independent institution and it is not controlled and managed by the University. However, the admission and examinations will be conducted by the University (TANUVAS) and Other administrative aspects will be governed on its own.</p>
12.	<p>Can I submit more than one application for the same degree course?</p> <p>Or</p> <p>I made mistake or wrong entry in the submitted application. Whether I need to submit one more application to rectify it?</p>	<p>No.</p> <p>A candidate can submit only one application using his / her registered mobile number and email. Please avoid duplicate entry. If you have made mistake or wrong entry, necessary correction may be done during the time period allotted for correction.</p> <p>If more than one application for the same degree programme is submitted, only one application will be considered for further processing. Application fee will not be refunded in any case.</p>
13.	<p>Can I edit my application after final submission?</p> <p>Or</p> <p>How to make correction of any wrong entry once the application is submitted?</p>	<p>Once the final submission of application / last date of submission is over, there will be a correction window, opened for 2-3 days after the last date of submission. The applicant can make the corrections if entered wrong. However, the applicants are advised to be careful, while filling up of application itself and check the particulars during preview of application before submission.</p>

Sl. No.	Questions	Answers
14.	I have submitted application for one degree programme (BVSc& AH). Later, I want to apply for BTech degree programme. Can I apply?	Yes. You can apply before the last date of submission of applications. Already used Mobile number and email ID for the first application cannot be used for the second application. Please note that all communications will be sent to the respective registered mobile number and email ID. Please regularly check for any communications in both the registered mobile number and email ID.
15.	Whether any candidate can apply afresh (with new application) during the correction window period?	No. New applications cannot be possible during the correction window period. Only corrections can be made by the applicant who have submitted the application earlier i.e. on or before the last date of submission of application.
16.	Should I also submit the printed copy of filled in application through post? (Or) Whether I have to come in person to submit the application?	No. The application for UG admission in TANUVAS should be sent only through online mode. Hard copy of the application will not be accepted.
17.	If I applied for admission under special categories (Sports / Differently abled / Children of Ex-serviceman) or Government School students under 7.5 % reservation, am I eligible under general quota also?	Yes. You will be considered for both special and general categories. If you are eligible, you can verify your rank in separate rank lists released for general and respective special categories. Initially counselling will be conducted for special categories based on merit. If you didn't get the seat under special category, you will be considered for General Category based on the rank. If you get the seat under both General and Special category, you can decide at that time based on the allotted campus and fee structure.

18.	<p>I have applied for BVSc & AH under Tamil Nadu state quota.</p> <p>I am planning to apply for All India quota</p> <p>I am also planning to apply for NRI sponsored quota?</p> <p>Is it possible to apply under different categories simultaneously.</p>	<p>Yes. You can.</p> <p>All India quota seats will be processed by the Veterinary Council of India (VCI) through separate application procedure.</p> <p>For Tamil Nadu and NRI sponsored quota, processing will be done separately and eligibility will be verified based on the specified norms.</p>
19.	<p>How to calculate aggregate marks for admission to BVSc & AH / BTech courses?</p>	<p>Please refer to Section 4.5 - Mode of Selection in Prospectus for UG admission.</p>
20.	<p>In case of CBSE or Other Board, whether additional marks will be assigned for calculation of aggregate marks</p>	<p>Normalization procedure will be followed as specified in the Prospectus. If the highest marks in Tamil Nadu State Board and CBSE or Other Boards in each subject is 100%, then the marks secured in the subjects of different boards will be considered at par. Kindly refer the prospectus under section 4.5.1. Normalization.</p>
C. Payment		
21.	<p>There is problem in payment. I have paid the amount through online, but I did not receive any information about successful payment. But the amount is deducted in my bank account. How to resolve this issue. Whether I need to pay once again?</p>	<p>Generation of application numbers (eg. BV01902 or BT00258) indicates the successful payment.</p> <p>If application number is not generated and amount is deducted in your bank account, the amount will be refunded within 7 bank working days to your account and your application will be in unsubmitted status. You have to make payment for generation of application. If amount is not refunded beyond the specified time period, please contact our technical team (Helpdesk) or bank.</p>

22.	Whether any concessions are available in application fee?	Yes. Application fee concessions are available for SC/SCA/ST categories (50% of application fee of General categories). Refer the Prospectus Section 15. Instructions to fill online application.
23.	Whether application fee will be refunded for rejected applications? or If I didn't get admission, whether application fee will be refunded?	No. Application once submitted, application fee will not be refunded on any grounds.
D.	Rank list and Counselling	
24.	When will the rank list be released? Or How do I know my rank?	The rank list will be released after processing of submitted applications and the rank list will be hosted in University website. Candidate may know their rank by searching their application number in the published rank list.
25.	Even though, I got same aggregate mark, my rank is lower than the few candidates. What is the reason for it?	If the candidates' aggregate marks are equal, procedure for assessing in Inter-se Merit will be followed as mentioned in the Prospectus in Section 4.5.2.
26.	How do I know about the date of counselling?	Intimation (Date and mode of counselling) will be sent to registered mobile number and email ID of the eligible candidates prior to the start of Counselling. They can also check the University website regularly for updates.
27.	Whether the candidates need to come In person for counselling ?	Differently abled candidates need to come In person at the mentioned venue, date and time for the physical examination by the medical board. For sports quota, the candidate might be requested to come for original certificate and related documents verification (if needed), which will be intimated.

Sl. No.	Questions	Answers
28.	Whether the preference for college, entered once, can be changed?	In general, once the application with all necessary entries and enclosures is finally submitted, preferences can not be changed. However, there will be a provision made for making changes in the application through opening of correction window, which will be given for 2-3 days after the last date of submission. During this period, the applicant can make the corrections (if any) in the entries. Similarly, there will be a chance to fill their preference of colleges during the registration of Online counselling.
29.	If I missed to register for Counselling, can I participate in subsequent round of counselling?	No. If you miss to register for the Counselling within the stipulated date and time, you will not be considered for further counselling on any grounds.
30.	I got the allotment letter and I missed to pay the fee within the prescribed date and time due to personal or any other reason. Can I join afterwards?	No. Once you fail to report, submit the original certificates and pay the fee at the mentioned venue, it is not possible to join afterwards. It is because, if you fail to join, your vacant seat will be allotted to next eligible candidate. Also, you will not be considered for further counselling.
31.	If I belong to "BC/BCM/MBC/SC/SCA/ST" category, Am I eligible under OC?	Yes. You will be considered in OC based on merit. Once seats under OC are filled, you will be considered under respective communities based on merit.
32.	I got the seat in least preferred college. Will I get the seat in the preferred college in future?	Yes. If you give sliding option at the time of reporting and fee payment. You will be considered for the campus change, depending upon the resultant vacancy and merit. Those who got first preferred campus, sliding option is not permitted.

33.	<p>I have already joined in “XXXX College”. I am having original HSC mark sheet, but not having my original Transfer Certificate. But I have original Bonafide certificate from the joined college.</p> <p>Can I join in the Veterinary / BTech College using the Bonafide certificate in case of selection?</p>	<p>Till participation in Counselling, Bonafide certificate is accepted.</p> <p>However if you are selected and got allotment letter, you need to report and submit all original certificates including original TC (Transfer Certificate) before the stipulated date and time. In that case only, you will be allowed for admission / fee payment only with the Original TC.</p> <p>Bonafide certificate will not be accepted for fee payment.</p>
34.	<p>Is it possible to interchange the college with my friend / relative /any other person after admission?</p>	<p>It is not possible. Campus change is possible only through sliding based on the order of merit and preference.</p>
E. NRI quota		
35.	<p>In NRI quota, whether, friends of my parents or nephew / niece or blood relative’s spouse can act as the NRI sponsorer?</p>	<p>No.</p> <p>Candidate’s direct blood relative viz., Own brother / own sister / father / mother / own brother or own sister of father / own brother or own sister of mother can only act as NRI sponsorer for NRI quota.</p>
F. Others		
36.	<p>For BVSc & AH, Is there any private Veterinary Colleges affiliated to TANUVAS or in Tamil Nadu?</p>	<p>No. There are no Private Veterinary Colleges available in Tamil Nadu.</p>
37.	<p>Whether any management quota is available in TANUVAS UG admission?</p>	<p>No. Management seats are not available in TANUVAS UG admission. Kindly refer the number of seats in Prospectus.</p>
38.	<p>I am unable to study in a particular campus due to medical grounds or any other grounds. Can I migrate to other colleges after opening of college or in consecutive years?</p>	<p>No.</p> <p>It is not possible to migrate from one college to other college on any grounds.</p>

Whom I have to contact for any queries while filling-up the application?	<p>Kindly read the prospectus in the respective sections carefully.</p> <p>In case of further queries, you can send queries using dashboard or email to admission@tanuvas.org.in for any clarification.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Contact the helpdesk through the given phone number during the mentioned time period.</p>
