ONLINE COUNSELLING INSTRUCTIONS

1. One-time Counselling Registration:

The candidate should register (One-time) for the Online Counselling within the stipulated date and time mentioned in the Counselling schedule, failing which they will lose their chance of admission. Also, candidates who failed to register for counselling and pay the prescribed counseling fee will not be considered for future rounds of counselling at any cost. In case of any difficulty in registration, the eligible candidates can contact admission committee through phone (mentioned in the helpline - 044 – 29997349 & 044 – 29997348) or email (admission@tanuvas.org.in).

2. No Guarantee of Admission:

Participation in the Online Counselling process **DOES NOT** offer any guarantee for admission to BVSc & AH / BTech degree programme.

3. Preference filling:

The candidates must select their **preferred campus** for BVSc & AH, BTech (Food Technology), BTech (Dairy Technology) and BTech (Poultry Technology) programmes. **The campus preference submitted by the candidate during the counselling process shall be treated as final. Requests for any change or modification after submission will not be entertained under any circumstances.**

4. Allotment:

The candidates who are participating in the Online Counselling will be selected on the basis of the **aggregate marks** obtained (as mentioned in the Prospectus) by following the **community reservation rules** of Tamil Nadu Government; on the basis of the **vacancy position** available at the constituent colleges of the University and **preference made** by the candidate for the campus. If there is no vacancy in the first preferred campus, the second preferred college will be allotted and so on, till all the

seats are filled. **The candidates should give utmost care in filling their order of campus preference, as further modification in the preference is not possible at any cost.**

5. Reporting to respective colleges (in person):

The candidates who got allotment can download their admission letter issued by the Chairman, Admission Committee in the website <https://adm.tanuv.ac.in>. The candidate should report **IN PERSON to the Dean of the allotted college within the prescribed date and time for certificate verification, submission of original certificates and payment of fees.**

Failure in any one of the following will lead to the forfeiture of the seat offered and they will not be considered thereafter;

- a. Reporting to the allotted campus
- b. Submission of all the original certificates as mentioned in Admission letter / Allotment letter
- c. Payment of the prescribed fees within the prescribed date and time.

6. Change of campus for admitted candidates:

- During the time of reporting, certificate submission and fee payment, candidates who opt to change their campus, can register for campus change (one-time) and their preferred campus will be upgraded (through sliding), till they get their first preference based on vacancy and their preference pattern.
- If the candidates got admitted in the first preferred campus, they will not be considered for subsequent rounds of counselling for change of campus at any cost.
- **Admission in the allotted college does not offer any guarantee for change of campus for the respective degree programme.**
- Even if the admitted candidates did not get the first preferred campus and wish to continue in the same admitted campus, they **NEED NOT register for campus change** at the time of reporting.
- **Candidates who register for a campus change and are subsequently allotted a different campus will not be reverted to their original campus under any circumstances. Therefore, candidates are advised to exercise utmost care while opting for a campus change.**
