

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES UNDER DIFFERENTLY ABLED QUOTA

The applicants with the disabilities (40 to 80 %) viz., Locomotor Disability, including specified disabilities (Leprosy Cured Person, Acid attack victims, Others such as Amputation, Poliomyelitis, Intellectual Disability and Blood Disorders) are considered eligible to apply under Differently abled quota in TANUVAS Undergraduate Admission 2025-26.

However, candidate shall not be allowed admission if he or she suffers from the following disabilities, namely:

- disability of total body including disability of chest or spine
- disability of lower limb of more than 80%
- disability of upper limb
- visually handicapped candidates
- hearing disability candidates
- candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of their professional duties

Note: Candidates who wish to apply under Differently abled quota need to upload the relevant proof for consideration under this category. However, the eligibility for admission will be decided at the time of physical examination conducted by the Medical Board, constituted specifically for this purpose during counselling, based on the functional requirements / fitness of Differently abled candidates to pursue the degree programme and norms of Veterinary Council of India (VCI) as per Notification, F. No. 12-5/2015-VCI-Part III- Admission to the Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry degree course.
