## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- The rank list for the undergraduate degree programmes of TANUVAS is prepared separately for BVSc & AH (Academic and Vocational) and BTech (Academic) degree programmes. Further, separate rank list for 7.5% Government School quota, Sports, Differently abled and Children of Ex-servicemen has been generated and hosted in the website. Candidates can verify their rank by opening the rank list files in the concerned volume and finding it using search option (Control + F and typing their application number and clicking enter).
- The applications which didn't fulfill the eligibility criteria viz., Not a native of Tamil Nadu, Not satisfying minimum or maximum age limit, Not studied the mandatory subjects, Exceeding the maximum number of attempts, Not securing the minimum marks in the subjects or aggregate marks, etc were rejected. For further details kindly refer Prospectus.
- Method of calculation of aggregate marks for BVSc & AH and BTech is mentioned in Prospectus Page No. 19.
- The criteria followed for *inter-se-merit* in the rank list in case of equal aggregate marks is shown in prospectus page No. 19 & 20.
- Candidates can indicate any issues in provisional rank / merit list through mail to admission@tanuvas.org.in **on or before 22.10.2022.**
- **If the candidates are found to be ineligible or /and failed to submit any required certificates / documents within the prescribed date and time will lead to cancellation of admission at any point of time. The decision of the University shall be final.**
- The candidate should submit the following mandatory documents at the time of counseling / Reporting. In case of non-submission of such certificates, their candidature will be cancelled. **Additional time will not be given for submission of documents.**
  1. Proof of Date of birth
  2. Mark Sheet of HSC / CBSE / Equivalent Examination
  3. 11<sup>th</sup> Mark sheet for candidates who appeared Tamil Nadu HSC (12<sup>th</sup>) Examinations from the year 2019
  4. Transfer Certificate / evidence for having joined in other course (bonafide certificate) if applicable and Conduct certificate
  5. Permanent Community Certificate (if applicable)
  6. Nativity Certificate with a mention of **"Native state of Tamil Nadu by birth"** - Tamil Nadu native candidates who have passed any of the VIII, IX, X, XI and XII Standards or their equivalent examinations from schools situated outside Tamil Nadu.
  7. For 7.5% Government School candidates - Bonafide Certificate from 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> standards studied in Tamil Nadu Government School obtained from the concerned CEO
  8. First Graduate Certificate (If Applicable)
  9. Income Certificate for the candidates claiming fee exemption.
- Relevant certificates for special categories (Differently Abled / Sports / Children of Ex-Serviceman Certificates as prescribed in the prospectus (if applicable)
- Candidates are informed to view the websites <https://adm.tanuvas.ac.in> and <https://tanuvas.ac.in> regularly for further updates.

## **IN PERSON COUNSELLING INSTRUCTIONS**

1. The candidate should appear IN PERSON for Counselling.

2. **Call letters download**

Eligible candidates can download their Counselling call letters from the website <https://adm.tanuvas.ac.in> to attend the counseling. No Individual call letters will be sent to the candidates. Candidates are informed to read the instructions given in call letter carefully

3. **Counselling**

The candidate should report at the Counselling venue **one hour before** the stipulated time mentioned in the Counselling call letter on the specified date. Eligible candidates can attend the counseling as per the date, time and rank mentioned in the schedule even if they are unable to download their call letter from the website.

4. **Registering for counseling in person**

The candidate should register himself / herself for the Counselling within the stipulated time. They need to be present in the Counselling hall and respond when their names are read out / called, failing which they will lose their chance of being selected.

5. **Mere calling for counselling does not offer any guarantee for admission to BVSc & AH degree programme.**

6. **Allotment**

The candidates who have been called for the Counselling will be selected on the basis of the aggregate (cut off) marks obtained by them (as mentioned in the Prospectus) and also on the basis of the vacancy position available at the constituent colleges of the University following the community reservation rules of Tamil Nadu Government.

7. If the candidate has already joined in any other course, the candidate is advised **not to obtain Transfer and Conduct Certificates** from the Institution in which he / she is studying, as the Counselling in this University does not offer any guarantee for selection. Hence, the evidence for having joined in other courses should be produced at the time of Counselling.

8. **Fees**

The selected candidate shall pay the prescribed fees for the first professional year / semester at the time of admission, provided he / she has all the original certificates (including T.C).

## ONLINE COUNSELLING INSTRUCTIONS

### Academic stream (BVSc & AH and BTech) and Vocational Stream (BVSc & AH)

#### 1. Counselling cut off:

The eligible cut-off will be displayed in the TANUVAS website before the start of counselling based on the vacancy position. Intimation will be sent to the eligible candidates through SMS and e-mail. Eligible candidates (based on the Counselling Cut-off marks) need to login to the TANUVAS admission website (<https://adm.tanuvac.ac.in>) using their registered mobile number / e-mail ID.

#### 2. Registration / Participation:

The candidate should register for the Online Counselling within the stipulated date and time mentioned in the Counselling schedule, failing which they will lose their chance of admission. Failure of participation of eligible candidates (as that of counselling cut-off) in the respective round of counselling, they will not be considered for future round of counselling at any cost. #### 3. No Guarantee of Admission:

Mere participation in the Online Counselling DOES NOT offer any guarantee for admission to BVSc & AH / BTech degree programme.

#### 4. Preference filling:

The candidates who failed to register for online counselling WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION THEREAFTER. The candidates need to select their preference of campus in case of BVSc & AH and preference of course discipline in case of BTech (first as most preferred and so on and last preferred). The campus (for BVSc & AH) / course (for BTech) preference shall be made by the candidate only once for the counselling. The eligible candidates need to fill all the preference for the campus (BVSc & AH) / course (BTech) compulsorily.

#### 5. Allotment:

The candidates who are participating in the Online Counselling will be selected on the basis of the **aggregate marks** obtained (as mentioned in the Prospectus) by following the **community reservation rules** of Tamil Nadu Government and also on the basis of the **vacancy position** available at the constituent colleges of the University and **preference made** by the candidate for the campus (BVSc & AH) and course (BTech). If there is no vacancy in the first preferred campus / course, the second preferred college / course will be allotted and so on, till all the seats are filled. **The candidates should give utmost care in offering their order of preference, as further modification in the preference is not possible at any cost.**

**6. Reporting to respective colleges (In Person):**

The candidates who got allotment can download their admission letter issued by the Chairman, Admission Committee in the website <https://adm.tanuvas.ac.in> and <https://tanuvas.ac.in>. The candidate should report **IN PERSON to the Dean of the allotted college within the prescribed date and time for certificate verification, submission of original certificates and payment of fees.**

**Failure in any one of the following;**

- a. Reporting to the allotted campus
- b. Submission of all the original certificates as mentioned in Admission letter / Allotment letter
- c. Payment of the prescribed fees

within the prescribed date and time will lead to the forfeiture of the seat offered and **they will not be considered thereafter.**

**7. Change of campus (BVSc & AH) and course (BTech) for admitted candidates:**

For those candidates who have **admitted and joined the BVSc & AH / BTech course and who didn't get their first preference will be considered for campus (BVSc & AH) / course (BTech) change in the subsequent round of counseling based on their willingness submitted at the time of reporting.**

However, if the candidates got admitted in the first preferred campus / course, they will not be considered for subsequent counselling for change of campus (BVSc & AH) / course (BTech) at any cost. Only admitted candidates are eligible for participation in subsequent counselling for change of campus (BVSc & AH) / course (BTech) based on their willingness. The campus (BVSc & AH) / course (BTech) automatically allotted in the subsequent counselling cannot be changed at any cost and **it is considered as FINAL.**

- 8. Mere admission in the allotted college does not offer any guarantee for change of campus (BVSc & AH) / course (BTech) degree programme.** Even if the admitted candidate did not get the first preferred campus / course and wishes to continue in the same admitted campus / course, they need not give willingness for change of campus / course in subsequent round of counselling.
