SPECIAL CATEGORIES – IN-PERSON COUNSELLING INSTRUCTIONS

1. In person counselling

The candidate should appear **IN PERSON** for Counselling.

2. Counselling fee

Eligible candidates (as specified in counselling cutoff) can download their Counselling call letters on payment of **one-time counselling fee (non-refundable)** in the website <https://adm.tanuvvas.ac.in> to attend the counseling.

Mere calling for counselling and payment of Counselling fee does not offer any guarantee for admission to UG degree programme. If the candidate didn't get seat after participation in the counselling, they will be placed in Waiting list. Based on the vacancy position, they will be allowed to register for subsequent rounds of counselling, for which they need not pay any counselling fee again.

3. Call letters download

Eligible candidates can download the counselling call letters from TANUVAS admission website only and call letters will not be sent through post to the candidates. Candidates are informed to **read the instructions** given in call letter carefully.

4. Counselling

The eligible candidates should report at the Counselling venue **one hour before** the stipulated time mentioned in the Counselling call letter on the specified date, failing which they will not be considered for further counselling. Mere attending of counselling does not offer any guarantee for admission to UG degree programme.

5. Registering for counseling In-person

The candidate should register himself / herself for the Counselling within the stipulated time at the Counselling venue. They need to be present in the Counselling

Hall and respond when their names are read out / called, failing which they will lose their chance of being selected.

6. Physical Examination for the Differently abled candidates

The physical examination for the differently abled candidates will be conducted by the Medical Board constituted for the purpose. The candidates can submit the supporting documents during the physical examination. The eligibility will be verified by the Medical board and the **decision of the Medical Board is FINAL.**

7. Certificate Verification for other special categories and academic qualification

Certificates for other Special categories (Sports and Children of Ex-servicemen) will be verified at the Counselling venue for its genuineness. Further, certificate verification will also be done for academic qualification.

8. Allotment

The candidates who have been called for the Counselling will be selected on the basis of the aggregate (cut-off) marks obtained by them (as mentioned in the Prospectus) and on basis of the vacancy position available at the constituent colleges of the University.

9. Transfer and Conduct Certificates

If the candidate has already joined in any other course, the candidate is advised **not to obtain Transfer and Conduct Certificates** from the Institution in which he / she is studying, as the Counselling in this University does not offer any guarantee for selection. However, the evidence of having joined in other courses should be produced at the time of Counselling.

10. Fees

The selected candidate shall pay the prescribed fees for the first professional year / semester at the venue mentioned in the allotment letter, provided he / she should have all the original certificates, including Transfer Certificate.
