Note:

- Call letters can be downloaded by the eligible candidates from the University website.
- Eligible candidates should report **two hours prior to the scheduled time of examination** along with the call letter and necessary documents (as mentioned in the remarks)
- No candidates will be permitted for the examination 30 minutes after the start of the examination
- Common Entrance Examination (+2 level / Equivalent) to the eligible candidates for BVSc & AH will be conducted, covering the subjects of 50% Biology (Botany and Zoology), 25% Physics and 25% Chemistry (Refer Syllabus).
- Common Entrance Examination (+2 level / Equivalent) to the eligible candidates for BTech will be conducted, covering the subjects of 25% Maths, 25% Biology (Botany and Zoology), 25% Physics and 25% Chemistry (Refer Syllabus).
- The question paper will contain **100 questions with four responses**. Each question will carry one mark and the maximum marks will be 100. There is no negative marks for wrong answers. The examination will be of **two hours duration**.
- Answer should be shaded with a ball point pen provided by the University in the OMR Coding sheet. Care should be taken not to damage the OMR coding sheet.
- No mobile phones / electronic gadgets are allowed inside the examination hall.
- The University is not responsible for loss of any personal belongings.
- Mere attending the entrance examination will no way ensure the admission of the candidate.
